Completion of Acquisition of ESTECH Corporation from MSC.Software

As announced on February 1, 2006, Information Services International - Dentsu, Ltd. ("ISID") has been holding negotiations with MSC.Software Corporation ("MSC"), a US corporation, on the acquisition by ISID of all outstanding shares of ESTECH Corporation ("ESTECH"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of MSC. The procedures for share transfers were completed on March 14, 2006, and ESTECH joined the ISID group as a wholly-owned subsidiary.

1. Purposes of ESTECH acquisition and business expansion plans

(1) Strengthening solution-providing capabilities in the CAE field

ESTECH is an engineering consulting company with strong technical expertise in computer-aided engineering (CAE), which conducts prognostic evaluation of vibration, noise, mechanism, heat and other aspects of mechanical product performance, and technologies relating to tests undertaken by its laboratories.

In CAE, the key is to improve the credibility of analysis results by raising the accuracy of prognostication of an analytical model through verification and comparison with test results. In order to reduce trial manufacture and related expenses at manufacturers utilizing CAE for product design and development, it would be effective to put to practice highly credible analysis results supported by laboratorial testings. ESTECH's well-balanced expertise in advanced technologies for analysis and testing is available as a single source for large-scale analysis and testing assignments. Consulting services provided by ESTECH have received accolades from major manufacturers in the automobile, electrical and precision machinery industries.

ISID is also a pioneer in the CAE field in Japan, with an outstanding track record and a wealth of know-how. In fact, CAE is one of strong points of ISID, along with computer-aided design (CAD) and product lifecycle management (PLM). The addition of ESTECH to ISID group has further boosted strength of ISID group for providing solutions in the CAE field.

(2) Expansion of the value chain of the ISID group's solutions for manufacturers

As group companies involved in solution services for manufactures, ISID has under its wing iTiD

Consulting, Ltd., a provider of consulting services related to the product design and development processes at manufacturers, and ISID TechnoSolutions, Ltd., which has prowess in production technologies, notably three-dimensional CAD and mold design. ISID has established overseas subsidiaries in Shanghai, Hong Kong, Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand in order to support Japanese manufacturers in China and the Southeast Asian region. Also, in November 2005, ISID concluded a capital and business alliance deal with Elysium Co. Ltd., which boasts superior technologies for 3D data translation. In this way, through collaborations with group companies and business partners, the ISID group has created a value chain of solutions that deal with every phase of the manufacturing process ranging from product design and development to preparation for production, and laid out a framework for providing one-stop services.

ISID believe that the addition of ESTECH to the group will expand this value chain of solutions and make the group even better prepared for offering one-stop services. The ISID group intends to make efforts to provide valuable solutions and related services that can meet broad and various needs of manufacturers setting out to shorten product development periods, improve product quality and reduce costs, among other operational challenges.
